**Board Members present:** Ron Collins, Barbara Brooks, Howard Oedel, Ralph and Doug Arthur Cummings, and Kathy Begor.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the May 5 meeting were accepted.

**Treasurer's Report:** There was no action in our checking account this past month. The balance remains at \$1,407.60. Our NHPDIP account balance at the end of April was \$8496.28, the report for May has not yet been received. The Treasurer's report was accepted.

**Archivist Report:** While doing research, Ron was studying the 1790 Hebron census and noticed that of all the families listed in town at that time, only the Barnards and Hazeltons still have relatives living here.
